The 2007 Israel Prize winner, The Gevatron: The Israeli Kibbutz Singers, will perform with America's foremost Jewish choral ensemble, the Zamir Chorale of Boston, on Thursday evening, October 18, 7:30 p.m. at Congregation Kehillath Israel in Brookline.

The Israel Prize is the most prestigious honor awarded by the State of Israel and is presented annually for distinguished achievement in scholarship, the arts, or public service. The Gevatron, which received the award in May, was founded in the same year as Israel and is the best-known and most popular traditional folk-singing group in the country.

Those Were the Days - These Are the Songs, cosponsored by the Israeli Consulate of Boston and by Combined Jewish Philanthropies, will include Hebrew music in two very different forms - the exquisite artistry of the Zamir Chorale of Boston along with the rousing folk music of the Gevatron.
